Qualifications

- Possesses a Bachelor's degree or is a mature student at the junior or senior level in education, social work, psychology, or law enforcement or a mature adult
- Has experience in working with youth, especially in a preventative mode
- Demonstrates emotional maturity and sensitivity to cultural and individual differences in participants and their families; has a nonjudgmental view of people
- Able to handle job-related matters in a professional, diplomatic, and confidential manner
- Is able to perform the essential job functions
